Entries are invited from the undergraduate and post graduate departments of Humanities, Mass Communications/Mass Media, Film/TV, Journalism, and Arts, Science and Commerce courses run by colleges, universities, deemed universities and independent institutes across Maharashtra.

Eligibility

- Undergraduate or post graduate courses offering graduate and post graduate programmes in Mass Communication/Mass Media/Journalism/ Film/TV, Journalism, Arts, Science and Commerce courses
- Participating colleges/departments/institutes should have access to movie camera, editing and post production facilities
- Groups should comprise of four or more male and female students and a faculty member
